

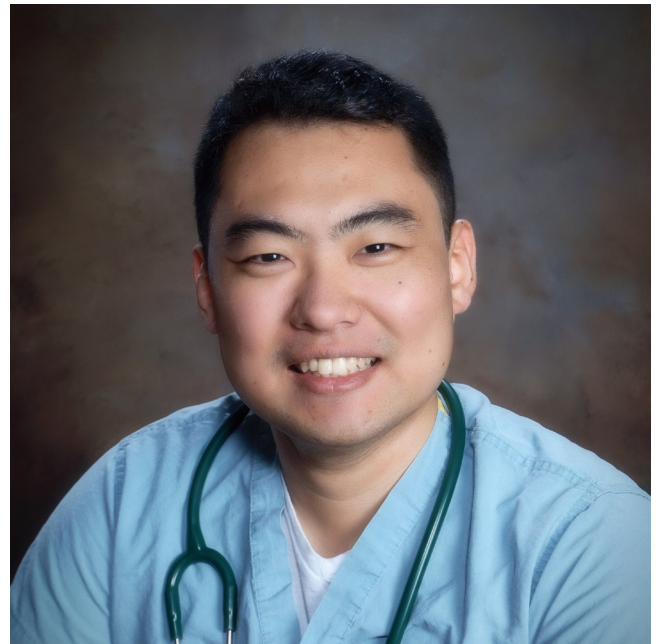
July Resident Physician of the Month
